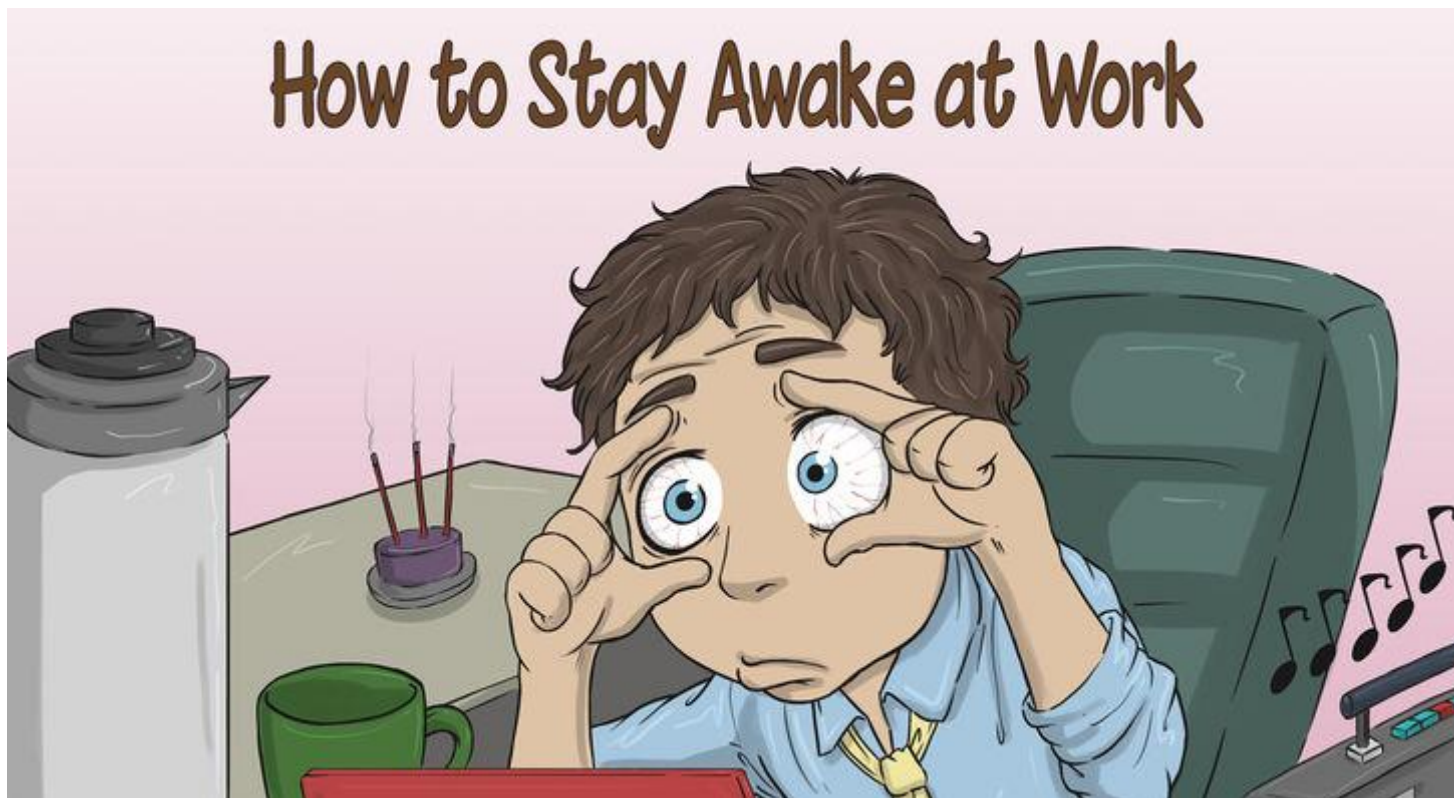

A typical meeting is attended by both citizens and officials, giving everyone a chance to talk personally in a relaxed environment about the things which matter to them.

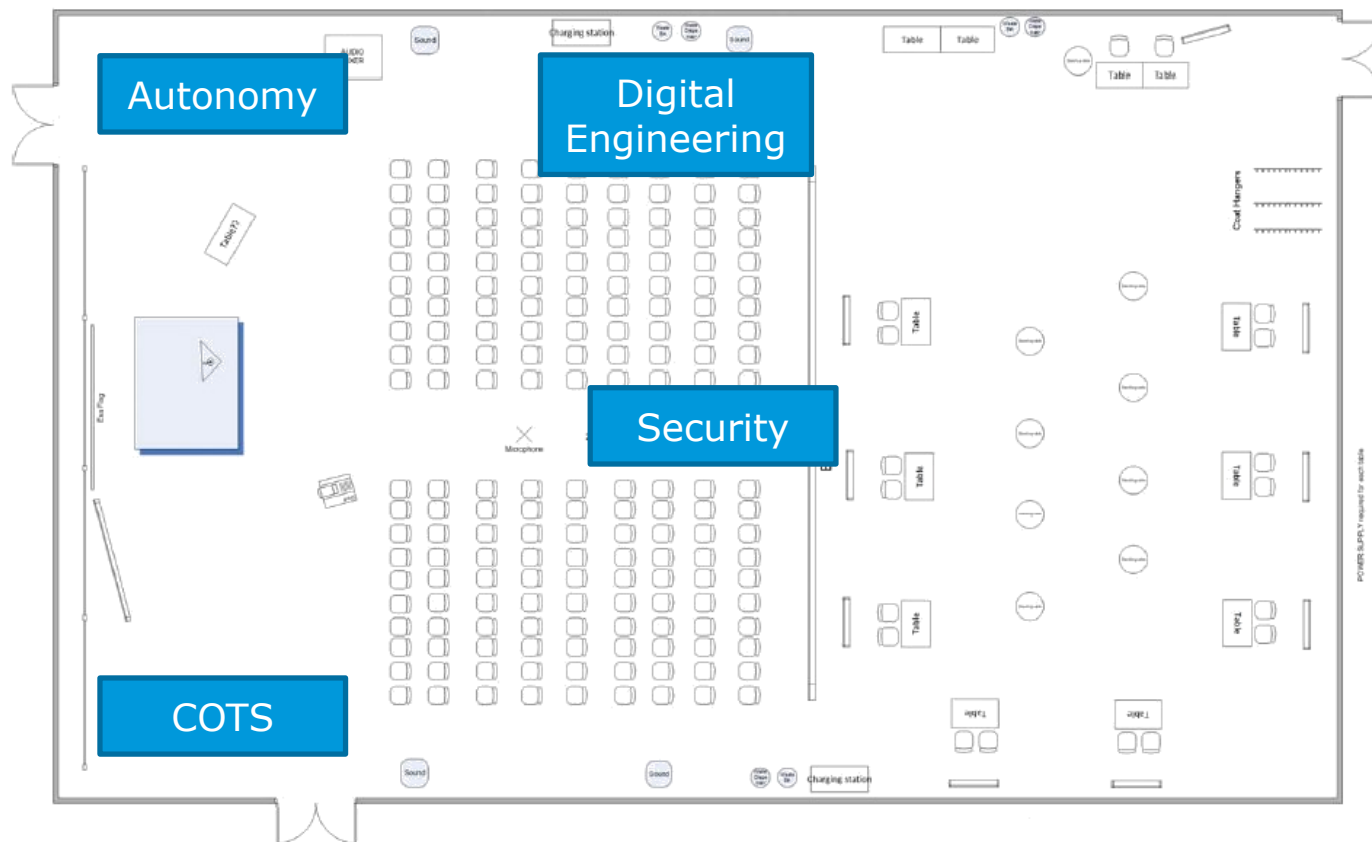
Typically, the organization and leadership are minimal, encouraging people to settle their differences amicably and with help from friends.
