

### **Clean Earth in a Clean Space**



Space is becoming more and more part of the modern economic infrastructure Space is becoming part of most human activities on Earth

### A few Commandments



Satellites end-of-life shall be managed

Demisability: the most effective, safest and cheapest way

For no longer manoeuvrable satellites: removal by ADR

Removal by ADR shall be rendered 'secure' by foreseeing it in the design phase => New ESA EO Sentinels will all be equipped with an interface simplifying RVD, grabbing and minimising tumbling

Removal by ADR is not an alternative to demisability but an addition
