Sub-arcsecond accuracy and near-real-time ephemerides

Preventing Debris Generation: From Light Curves to Attitude Models

Preventing Debris Generation – Object Characterization:

- Light curves feed into 3D shape and attitude models
- Understanding tumbling behavior for safe removal
- Investing in AI-based attitude reconstruction
- Future: 'Characterization-as-a-Service' for operators and removal missions
